

Four-Plus-One Program of Study Admission to Masters Degree of Stevens Institute of Technology, USA

The Malaviya National Institute of Technology (MNIT) Jaipur has signed an agreement for student exchange with Stevens Institute of Technology (Stevens), USA. Established in 1870, Stevens is one of the oldest and most respected engineering colleges in the United States with a broad range of programs in engineering, science and technology management. The Stevens Campus is situated on the banks of the Hudson River with easy access to New York City.

The agreement with Stevens allows students to obtain a Maser of Science or Master of Engineering degree from a prestigious U.S. University in shorter time and at an approximately **33% reduction in cost**. Depending on the chosen Stevens degree, the “Four-plus-One student exchange program allows the MNIT undergraduate students to take up to **three or four graduate** courses at MNIT in the third and fourth year of their undergraduate program. These courses will be recognized by Stevens thereby reducing the time and cost of obtaining the Stevens degree.

The estimated total tuition and living cost to obtain a Stevens degree in 2008-09 under the Four-Plus-One option is approximately US \$36,000. The savings in Stevens tuition fees for the masters degree is US \$9,360 (Engineering or Science) and \$12,480 (Technology Management). Additional savings will come from reduced time spent in the U.S. before obtaining the degree. Detailed cost estimates are available at the above site.

To be eligible for the Four-Plus-One Program, MNIT students must have obtained minimum of 7.5 GPA in first three years of undergraduate study at MNIT.

Note that Stevens can admit four-plus-one students in either the fall or spring semesters.

ELIGIBILITY FOR REGISTERING IN THE COURSES FLOATED AT MNIT :

- (1) Student must be studying in III or IV year B.Tech. of MNIT Jaipur
- (2) Must have obtained 7.5 CPGA in first three years of undergraduate studies

Fee to Be Paid

1. Rs. 50,000/- (fifty-thousand rupees) for each course (maximum 2 courses allowed per semester)
