MINUTES OF 62ND SENATE MEETING HELD 08TH APRIL 2026

The 62nd meeting of the Senate was held on 08th April 2026 from 4:00 PM onwards in Niti Sabhagar, Prabha Bhawan of the Institute. The attendance list is placed at **Annexure-A**.

The Chairman Senate, in his opening remarks, welcomed all members attending the meeting.

The agenda items were discussed one by one, and resolutions for each agenda items are as follows:

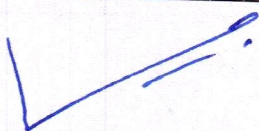
<i>Item No. 62-1.0</i>	:	To confirm the minutes of 61 st meeting of the Senate. The Senate confirmed the minutes of the 61st meeting with the following minor modifications: 1. Resolution No. 61-3.2: The introduction of the self-financed admission category is also extended to the M.Plan program in addition to the M.Tech programs. 2. Resolution No. 61-3.6: The Senate recommended expanding the UG Curriculum Review Committee by including at least one faculty member from each department. It was further suggested to include four meritorious UG students in the committee.
<i>Item No. 62-2.0</i>	:	To note the "Action Taken" on the decisions taken in the 61 st meeting of the Senate. The Senate noted the action taken report on the decision/resolutions taken in its 61 st meeting.
<i>Item No. 62-3.0</i>	:	Item for consideration.
<i>Item No. 62-3.1</i>	:	To consider the Academic Calendar for Academic Year 2026-27. The Senate considered the Academic Calendar for the Academic Year 2026-27 and approved the same.
<i>Item No. 62-3.2</i>	:	To consider the revised Scheme and Syllabi of the M.Tech. Programme "Semiconductor Materials and Devices" proposed by the Materials Research Centre (MRC). After due deliberation, the Senate approved the revised Scheme and Syllabi, along with the eligibility criteria for admissions to the programme. The Senate also recommended that the programme be started with an intake of 15 seats.

(Renewable Energy) from 16 to 26 in the Centre for Energy and Environment.</p> <p>After due deliberation, the Senate approved the increase in student intake from 16 to 26 seats for the M.Tech. (Renewable Energy) programme.</p>
Item No. 62-3.5	:	<p>To consider offering a single M.Tech. programme in Chemical Engineering and Sustainability in the Department of Chemical Engineering in place of the earlier two programmes.</p> <p>Upon consideration, the Senate approved the proposal to offer a single M.Tech. programme in "Chemical Engineering and Sustainability," replacing the existing two programmes.</p>
Item No. 62-3.6	:	<p>To consider the proposal for initiating a merit-based scholarship for meritorious students admitted through JoSAA at MNIT Jaipur.</p> <p>Following detailed discussion, the Senate approved the introduction of a merit-based scholarship scheme titled 'Malaviya Ratna Award' with the following provisions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number of Recipients: Top five students per academic year for B.Tech, and one top student per academic year for B.Arch. • Financial Support: ₹2,00,000 per annum per student to cover tuition fees, hostel charges, institute fees, and mess expenses. • Eligibility Criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ B.Tech: Candidates admitted under the Open Category (gender-neutral) with an All India Rank (AIR) of up to 1500 through JoSAA. ◦ B.Arch: Candidates admitted under the Open Category (gender-neutral) with an AIR of up to 200 through JoSAA. • Continuation: Scholarship renewal is subject to maintaining a minimum CGPA of 8.0 each semester and satisfactory conduct. <p>The Senate further recommended that the financial implications and the proposed source of funding, from Institute Revenue Generation (IRG) funds, be placed before the Finance Committee (FC) and the Board of Governors (BoG) of MNIT Jaipur for consideration and approval.</p>
Item No. 62-3.7	:	<p>To consider the revised minimum qualification for PG admissions through CCMT in Mechanical Engineering Department.</p> <p>As per the directions of the Senate, the department has reviewed the GATE papers along with the qualifying degrees required for admission to the M.Tech programs in Industrial Engineering and Thermal Engineering through CCMT. The revised list of applicable GATE papers and corresponding qualifying degrees for these programs is attached as Annexure B.</p>
Item No. 62-3.8	:	To consider the matter regarding Inactive UG Students who were not registered/absent for more than 2 semesters.

- A Master's degree in any branch of Mathematics (S519), Statistics (S525), Computer Applications (S509), or equivalent.
