## 3. Event Highlights

### Description:

Dicey Dares was designed as a board-game-inspired challenge where teams of two players rolled dice to navigate a board marked with different states. Each state was linked to a unique activity, adding an element of unpredictability and excitement to the game. The key twist was that when a team landed on a state, the opposing team selected the challenge the active player had to complete within a given time frame.

### **Game Rules:**

Each team consisted of **minimum 2 and maximum 4**.

- Players took **turns rolling the dice** to advance on the board.
- When a team landed on a state, the **opposing team chose a challenge** from the given list.
- Only **one player performed the task** at a time.
- **Failing a task** resulted in losing a turn.
- The first team to **reach the finish line** after successfully completing challenges was declared the winner.

### **Types of Challenges:**

The event featured a variety of challenges, including:

- **Physical Tasks** – endurance-based challenges to test agility and coordination.
- **Creative Tasks** – puzzles and artistic activities to test innovation and expression.
- **Problem-Solving Tasks** – logic-based challenges to test critical thinking.

### **Audience Participation & Response**

The event witnessed an enthusiastic turnout of approximately 100+ participants who enjoyed the engaging format and competitive spirit. The innovative approach of integrating a board-game structure with interactive challenges made it one of the most exciting events of the festival.

Participants appreciated the unique structure, mentioning that it effectively combined entertainment with skill-based tasks. Many suggested hosting similar interactive events in future festivals to encourage teamwork and strategic thinking in an enjoyable setting.

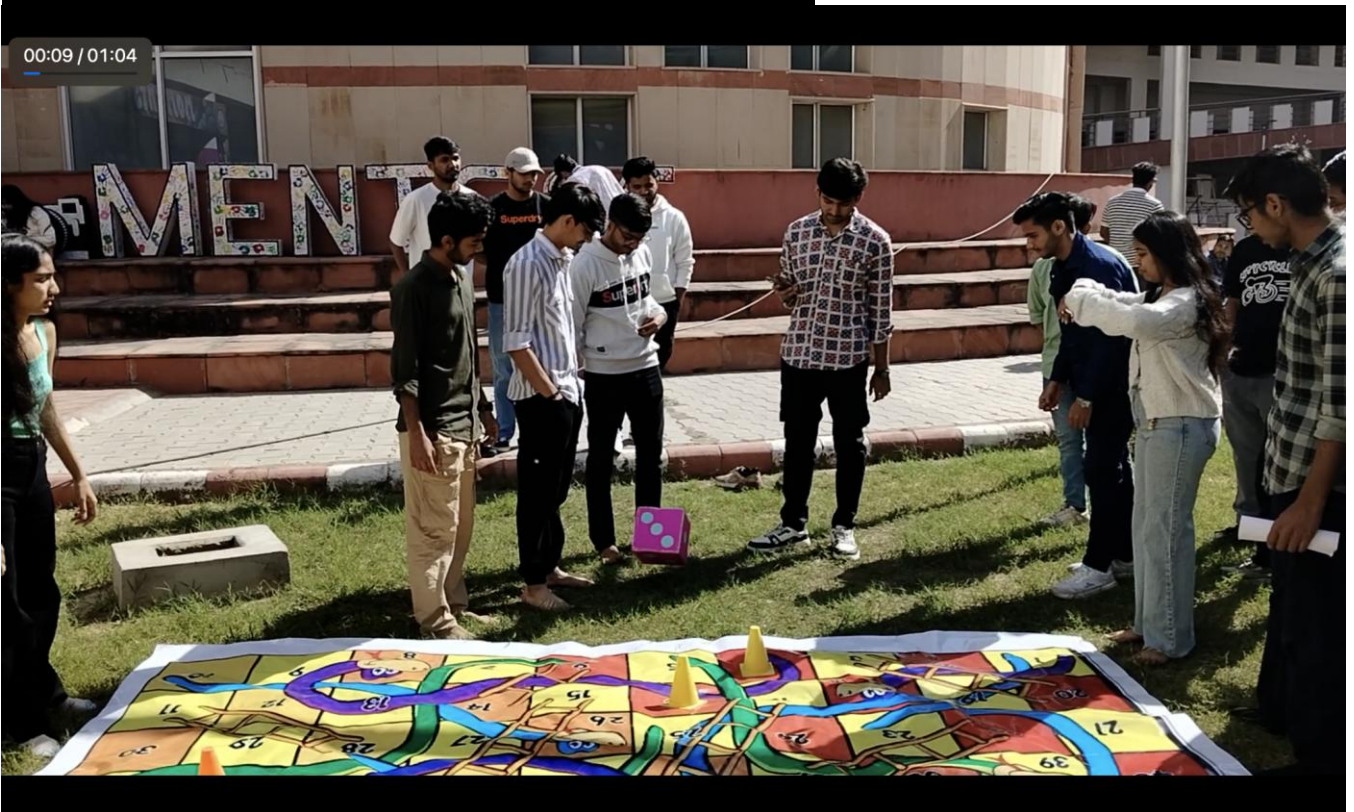
### **Suggestions for Improvement:**
