2. Introduction

The quiz was designed to challenge both casual viewers and hardcore cinephiles, fostering a competitive yet fun-filled environment.

Objective:

3. Event Highlights

Description:

The event featured **three engaging rounds**, each with its unique format and challenges. Teams competed fiercely to showcase their cinematic expertise, and the atmosphere remained energetic throughout.

Round Details:

1. First Round: Scene Guessing (Movie & Web Series Identification)

- Participants were shown short scenes from popular movies and web series projected on a screen.
- They had to identify the name of the movie or series based on visual clues.
- Points were awarded for correct answers, while incorrect guesses resulted in negative points.

2. Second Round: Buzzer Round (Advertisement Audio Challenge)

- Contestants listened to audio clips of famous advertisements played on a speaker.
- Using buzzers, they had to quickly guess the product being advertised.
- Speed and accuracy were key as only the first correct answer earned points.

3. Third Round: Cinematography Quiz

- A set of **10 questions** related to cinematography techniques, camera equipment, lighting, and iconic filmmakers was presented.
- This round required deeper technical knowledge and rewarded participants who demonstrated a strong understanding of the art of filmmaking.

Participants' Feedback:


Attendees described the quiz as:
