Objective (Electronics & ICT Academy-Phase II)

1) To conduct specialized FDPs for faculty/mentor training in line with the vision of MeitY in high-priority areas supporting the "Make in India" and the "Digital India" programs.

2) To promote synergy and collaboration with industry, academia, universities and other institutions of learning

3) To support the National Policy on Electronics 2019 (NPE 2019), which envisions positioning India as a global hub for ESDM sector, including MeitY Schemes/policies such as Programme for Semiconductors and Display Fab Ecosystem; India AI; National Programme on AI, Production Linked Incentive Scheme for IT Hardware & Large-Scale Electronics Manufacturing; EMC; SPECS; Chips to System (C2S); etc.

4) To promote standardization of FDPs through Joint Faculty Development Programmes.

An intensive 40-Hour (10 days) Training Programme in hybrid mode is being organized at Indian Institute of Information Technology Kota (IIIT Kota) for faculty, doctoral students of engineering and technological institutions. Working professionals from industry/organizations are also invited to attend. The main theme of the training program will be oriented around exploring the state-of-the-art methods for **Next-Generation Intelligent Computing and Secure Systems**. The programme is scheduled from **9:00 AM to 11:00 AM** and **12:30 PM to 3:30 PM**, running from December 7th to December 16th.

Programme Modules:

1. Foundations of Next-Generation Computing Systems (Evolution of computing, intelligent and secure system requirements)
2. Artificial Intelligence for Intelligent Computing (Machine learning, deep learning, decision intelligence, applications)
3. Quantum Computing and Quantum-Aware Systems (Qubits, quantum algorithms, quantum advantage, security implications)
4. Blockchain and Distributed Trust Systems (Decentralization, consensus, smart contracts, trusted architectures)
5. Cyber Security and Privacy-Preserving Technologies (Cryptography, network security, threat models, privacy techniques)
6. Integration of Intelligent and Secure Systems (AI security, blockchain-AI integration, post-quantum security, use cases)
